

At its size and with its range of features, the QuadSport 80 is built for riders 16 years and older, as well as for adult-supervised riders 12 and older. It has an automatic clutch with a variable-speed V-belt transmission to eliminate clutching and shifting and provide smooth acceleration. Its low seat height and 220-pound dry weight make it more maneuverable than larger machines. And its single A-arm, oil damped front suspension and single-shock rear suspension — unique to its class — provide the smooth ride that beginners are looking for.

Parents in particular appreciate the variety of features designed for use while a youngster is learning. A built-in throttle limiter controls the speed, and an ignition lock-out prevents the engine from starting unless the parking brake is engaged.

Adults must always supervise riders under 16. All other Suzuki ATVs may be used only by those 16 and older.

Always keep safety in mind. ATVs can be hazardous to operate. For your safety, always wear a helmet, eye protection and protective clothing. Never ride on paved surfaces or public roads. Never carry passengers or engage in stunt riding. Avoid excessive speeds. Riding and alcohol or other drugs don't mix. Be extra careful on difficult terrain.
